CLASS RACING STABLE OFF TO A SIZZLING START IN 2011



Black Hills closed strong from the rear on the final turn of a fast track and romped to a five-length victory in the \$100,000 Sunland Park Handicap in New Mexico on April 17, 2011, winning for the fourth time in five starts at Sunland Park. He registered his 10th lifetime win in 23 starts. He began 2011, by winning the Winsham Lad Stakes for the second straight year at Sunland on January 8, breaking the track record in the process.



Wiredfortwotwenty was named sprinter of the meet after winning the marquee event, the PHOENIX GOLD CUP at Turf Paradise on a sloppy track. This was his second consecutive Stakes win for 2011. The Cup win boosted his lifetime earnings to almost \$200,000. He led wire to wire and finished 5 1/4 lengths ahead in a field of eleven horses. This was his third consecutive win.



Surrey Star winner of the La Puente Stakes at Santa Anita relaxed and handled the turf real well. He is just starting to come into his own. It seems race by race he is getting better and better and he is learning a lot. James Cassidy, trainer of Surrey Star, said "It was a great run and a very nice ride. Jockey Joe Talamo had a lot of horse the whole trip. This colt will run a mile and a quarter."



La Nez raced to a big win in the Irish O'Brien Stakes. She ran a perfect trip breaking good and tucked in right behind some other horses. At the top of the lane Jockey Martin Pendroza put her into gear and she had one hell of a kick, she just took off. Eric Kruljac, trainer of La Nez said "She's won four \$100,000 stakes for Cal-breds, all out of the eight hole."

Current Runners Offering

La Nez This 4 year old G1 placed Cal-Bred filly and 4 time Stakes winner is one of the best fillies around. She already has residual value as a future broodmare and runs her heart out every race. Her numbers speak for themselves as she has earned \$393,000 winning her last start, the \$100,000 Irish O'Brien at Santa Anita. Her next scheduled start is in the \$250,000 My Juliet Stakes at Philadelphia Park on May 28th before coming back to Del Mar. Trainer is Eric Kruljac.

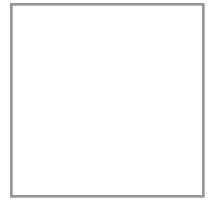
Surrey Star a multiple Graded place runner has been knocking heads with some of the best 3 year olds in the country. He won the \$100,000 La Puente Stakes on the turf at Santa Anita in April and in his most recent race ran a troubled 6th in the \$200K Grade 2 American Turf, beaten only 3 1/2 lengths for 2nd. There are several Graded races we are considering for this talented colt, including the Grade 2 \$600K Virginia Derby on July 16th. Trainer is Jim Cassidy.

Bauble Queen a 3 year old filly sired by Arch. Arch is the sire of **G1** Breeders Cup winner Blame (defeated Zenyatta) and has a total of three Champions. **Bauble Queen** is out of a Storm Cat dam, Muneefa. The bloodlines are impressive! Trainer Eric Kruljac believes she is one of the best young fillies he has ever trained and will be one of his stars at Del Mar. The current plan is to get a race in at Hollywood Park and be ready to rumble at Del Mar!

Oilisblackgold Sired by Tapit, whose stud fee has gone from \$50,000 in 2010 to \$80,000 in 2011. This 4 year old gelding has been knocking heads with some of the best horses in California. He ran 5th in the **G2** Strub Stakes to Twirling Candy, finished 2nd to Gladding, **G2** winner of the San Antonio, lost by a neck to Tweebster, a multiple **G2** placed horse; and beat Setsuko who was beaten by a nose in the **G1** Santa Anita Handicap. The current plan is to get a race into him at Hollywood Park and be prepared for some stakes races at Del Mar. Trainer is Craig Dollase.

Elusive Buzz

Class Racing Stable has purchased a 3 year old colt out of the outstanding sire **Elusive Quality**. He also sired **Smarty Jones G1 Kentucky Derby** winner, **Raven's Pass G1 Breeders Cup** winner, and **Quality Road G1 Met Mile** winner. **Elusive Quality** was ranked 7th nationally as a sire in earnings for 2010 with over \$7.1 million. His sire, **Gone West**, was a **G1** winner and was one of the premier milers of his day.

The dam, **Candleinthedark**, was a **G3** placed runner with earnings of \$199,696. She has produced 3 to race with 2 winners and is by the sire of **Cox's Ridge G1 Met Mile** winner. The second dam, **Key to the Bridge**, a **G3** winner and sister to **Plugged Nickel**, a champion sprinter. She has produced 3 black type runners including **G2** winner **Islefaxyou**.

Elusive Buzz is currently at Rancho Paseana and will resume training in June.

Off the Rack

Class Racing Stable has purchased a 2 year old Kentucky bred colt named **Off the Rack**. He is the son of the sire **Silver Train** out of **Pentelicus**. The top side sire **Silver Train** was a tremendous performer winning **4 Graded** races. He won the **G1 Breeders Cup Sprint** and the **G1 Met Mile** with a lifetime earnings of \$1.3 million. **Silver Train** is by **Old Trieste** out of the **A.P. Indy** family. He is a young stallion with his first foals turning 3 years old this year. He is the leading speed horse stud from the **A.P. Indy/Seattle Slew** sire lines. He is a top 10 freshman sire in 2010 by earnings and a top 5 freshman sire by individual winners. **Silver Train's** dam, **Ridden in Thestars**, was a **Stakes** placed runner and produced 6 winners from 7 foals. The third dam, **Shelter Strait**, produced 5 foals and 5 winners, 2 of them being either **Stakes** winners or **Stakes** placed.



The bottom side has a strong pedigree with the first 2 dams producing 12 runners, 10 of them winners. The first dam, **Designer Label**, produced a **G1** placed winner at Saratoga. She has had 3 to race with 2 winners. **Designer Label's**, sire **Pentelicus** was a multiple **Stakes** winner and **Stakes** placed runner who was by **Fappiano**, winner of the **G1 Met Mile**. The second dam, **Disclaimed**, by **Affirmed**, produced 9 foals with 8 winners, one a **Stakes** winner, **Call Fiorello**. The third dam, **Golden Horde**, was a **G1** route winner and was by the sire **Czaravich**, winner of the **G1 Met Mile**. She had 4 foals to race, 3 winners, with 2 of them being **Stakes** placed runners. This colt should love the dirt, slop, grass and based on his pedigree, the **G1 Met Mile**.

Instant Royalty

Class Racing Stable has purchased a 2 year old filly at the Ocala Sale. She is named **Instant Royalty** and is the daughter of the sire **Repent** out of **Broad Brush** dam. There is a strong bottom side pedigree with the first, second, and third dam having 15 foals to race with 14 winners. She should be able to route and turf with sires like **Ack Ack** and **The Prime Minister** on the bottom side. The first dam has 2 foals with 1 winner. The second dam was a turf mile winner and produced 4 foals, all winners, including 1 **Stakes** winner. The third dam produced 10 foals to race, 9 winners with 5 of the runners being **G2** and **G3** winners and placed.

The top side is strong with the sire **Repent**, a multiple **Graded** winner, running 2nd as a 2 year old in the **G1 Breeders Cup Juvenile** and winning the **G2 Louisiana Derby** at 3. He has produced **12 black type** winners. His sire was **Louis Quatorze**, who as a 3 year old won the **G1 Preakness** and ran second in the **G1 Breeders Cup Classic**. **Repent's** dam, **Baby Grace**, was a **Stakes** placed route winner. The third dam, **Kathy**, produced a **G1** winner. Jim Cassidy will be the trainer.
