Footnotes

BORN FLIRT had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, regained the advantage in the stretch, kicked clear under urging past midstretch and proved best. LUNCH TIME DIVA close up stalking the pace inside, waited briefly off the heels of the winner in midstretch, got through along the fence and edged a rival for the place. GONELIKEAHURRICANE had speed between horses then dueled outside the winner, put a head in front on the turn, fought back in the stretch and was edged for second but held third. HIGHLY COMPOSED (GB) was in a good position stalking the pace between horses to the stretch, continued between foes in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. RIVER'S MAMBO wide early, stalked the pace three deep to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. AROUND THE TWIG between horses early, chased off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AMOROUSLY stalked the pace four wide on the backstretch and steadied in tight a half mile out, angled in some for the turn, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and lacked a further response. WEEKEND PARTY broke out a bit, chased inside then came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into the turn and five wide into the stretch and did not rally.
