BIG SON OF A GUN stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn to take the lead, inched away and angled in some into the stretch and drew off under a strong hand ride, a crack of the whip and a snug hold late. DOC CAN DANCE dueled between horses then stalked between foes, angled in and battled inside on the second turn, was no match for the winner in the stretch and just held the place. BIG KISS dueled three deep between foes then stalked on the backstretch, continued alongside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for second. ALERT ROCKET broke a bit slowly, pulled his way along a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the second turn and lacked a further response. TAK GAMO prompted the pace four wide on the first turn then three deep, took the lead on the backstretch, inched away, battled briefly between horses nearing midway on the second turn and gave way. JUST GETIN STARTED had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked on the backstretch, dropped back into the second turn, gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
